Description			
Running board_status.sh from live environments seems like a good idea at first sight. However, board_status.sh does not check git identities beforehand and only prints warnings during uploading process. In fact, it fails (more or less silently) to commit the changes due to not configured git identity. Now, even if you set the git identity afterwards and re-run it, it refuses to file the board_status because it says that it's a duplicate, while in fact the previous report was not uploaded at all. So imho we have two problems here: * board_status.sh does not check git identities beforehand * board_status reports false positives regarding duplicate status
